## Day 1: Hanoi arrival - Half day tour (-/L/D)



Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum





Hoan Kiem Lake

Upon on your flight at Noi Bai airport, tour guide and driver will pick you up and transfer to visit the **Ho Chi Minh Complex**, which includes Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum - the final resting place of the beloved national hero, Uncle Ho - and President Ho Chi Minh's stilt house where he lived off and on from 1958 to 1969. Enjoy the architectural and historical aspects of Uncle Ho's final resting-palace lying to one side of the Mausoleum is the **One Pillar Pagoda**, built by King Ly Thai To in 1049 the structure has become an important symbol for the people of Hanoi. After that, we will continue to visit the **Literature Temple** and **Quoc Tu Giam** – Vietnam's first University, constructed in 1070. Its gardens and well-preserved architecture offer a relaxing glimpse into Vietnam's past. Then we will stop at Hoan Kiem Lake (Sword Lake) and learn more about the lake's legend, visiting **outside of Ngoc Son Temple and Hanoi Old Quarter**.

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#### Day 2: Hanoi - Halong (B/L/D)

Leave for **Halong Bay** was awarded by UNESCO as a natural heritage in 1994. This four hour drive will show you the diversity of the North Vietnam villages and rice fields along the journey. Upon arrival, we start enjoying 4 hour boat trip. We walk into the **Thien Cung cave (Heaven Palace cave)** to see thousands of stalactites and stalagmites colored by hundreds of neon lights. After 1 hour stay in the **"Heaven Palace"**, we are back to the boat for cruising along the World Nature Heritage part to see the **Incense Bowl islet, Cock fighting islets Sail islet, Turtle Island....** A delicious seafood lunch will be served when we are completely relax on boat. We are both having seafood and seeing the wonderful sightseeing outside. Dinner at local restaurant and then check-in hotel. Free time to go shopping at **Halong Night Market.**

Transfer to Noibai airport for the domestic flight to Danang. Arrival Danang, transfer to hotel for check in.



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

#### Day 4: Danang - Bana hills - Danang (B/L/D)

Have breakfast at your hotel then the guide and driver will pick up you to transfer to Ba Na Hills. Arrive at the cable car station Suoi Mo. Sitting in the cabin, in mid air, looking upon the endless tree lone of the forest. Experiencing the pristine ecological system of the Ba Na mountain will leave you a sense of unforeseeable



Visit the **Le Jardin**, **old wineries (excluded expenses)** - remains of **French Villas** and **Linh Ung pagoda** with 27m high Buddha statue. Leave Le Jardin for Gare Debay, the second cable car station, to go to the top of Ba Na Visit and play game at the **Fantasy Park**- Ba Na Hills Fantasy Park- the third largest indoor amusement park in the world **(Only some free games depending on Ba Na policy).** 

Free around Ba Na Hill till go down to the foot of mountain. Back to hotel for rest

#### Day 5: Danang - Hoi An - Danang (B/L/D)

Morning: Travel to Cam Thanh coconut village. Board on boat (2 Persons 1 Boat) and commence cruising on the Cua Dai River. Join in local fisherman on the river and experience on round net or cast net. Explore the now tranquil coconut-palm flanked waterways.





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Enjoy a walking tour in Hoi An Ancient Town: Visit **Japanese Covered Bridge Pagoda**: the first bridge on this site was constructed in 1593 by the Japanese community of Hoi An to link the town with the Chinese quarters across the stream. The bridge was provided with a roof so it could be used as a shelter from rain and sun. Sa Huynh Museum: located near the **Japanese Covered Bridge**, it contains exhibitions from the earliest period of Hoi An's history. Tran Family Chapel: this house for worshipping ancestors was built about 200 years ago with donations from family members. The Tran family traces its origins to China and moved to Vietnam around 1700. The architecture of the building reflects the influence of Chinese and Japanese styles. **Phuoc Kien Assembly Hall**: Chinese pagoda built around 1690 and then restored and enlarged in 1900. It is typical of the Chinese clans that were established in the Hoi An area. The temple is dedicated to Thien Hau Thanh Mau (Goddess of the Sea and Protector of Sailors and Fishermen).

Afteroon: Free shopping at Han market and Con market
